regarding changes to the battery report template and fees for the collective fulfillment of battery take-back obligations

Dear clients,

On behalf of ECOBAT s.r.o., we would like to inform you of the following changes effective from January 1, 2026:

A) Change to the Report template (Appendix 1 to the contract)

The change is prompted by the entry into force of Chapter VIII of Regulation (EU) 2023/1542 of the European Parliament and of the Council, which introduces two new binding categories of batteries (light means of transport batteries and electric vehicle batteries) and amends certain definitions. We have taken the necessary changes into account without significantly altering the structure of the reports and will offer you online training in completing the new report template from 2026.

B) Change to the Tariff List (Appendix 2 to the Agreement)

Please allow us to briefly explain the reasons for the fee increase of certain items:

- a significant increase in the volume of batteries collected and costs since the last change for ZnC, ZnCl, and AlkMn batteries,
- a several-fold increase in prices for the processing of Li primary cylindrical, prismatic, and button batteries of all categories,
- a significant decrease in the silver content of AgO button batteries and the need to process them together with other button batteries.

On the contrary, the high efficiency of take-back and recycling of all types of Pb batteries allows us to significantly reduce the fees.

In the event that you do not agree with the announced changes, we would like to remind you of your right to withdraw from the contract within three weeks of receiving this notification, in accordance with Article VII, paragraph 3 of the contract (fee amendments).
